Seeds of Vandana Shiva

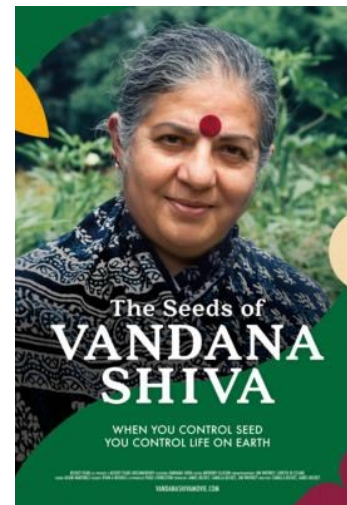

Sidik and the Panther

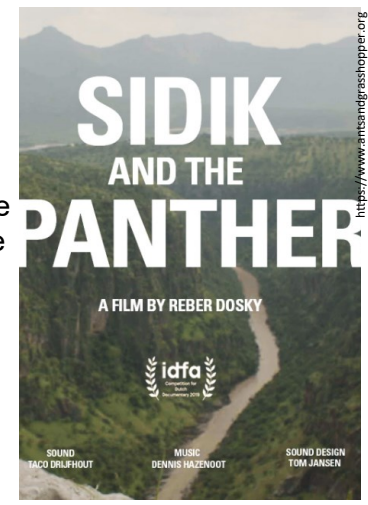
